A propos du Moot 擁抱M007 捕捉希望--四年一輪羅浮會

世界羅浮大會聚集了童軍運動中羅 浮階段的年輕人和其他成人領袖。 從1931年在瑞士的Kandersteg第一次 舉辦時就有二十個國家、近三千名 伙伴參與。雖然每年在世界各地都 有地區性的羅浮運動,但為了增廣 見聞、分享文化內涵、交流世界羅 浮童軍的友誼,1993年的世界童軍 會議決定每四年辦一次世界羅浮童 軍大會。

藉由Moot活動,讓全世界的羅浮童 軍彼此了解、包容、合作、成長, 就如同<mark>貝登堡</mark>説:「讓童軍承擔促 進和平與善意的責任」,而地球村 一系列<mark>的活動是</mark>想讓伙伴體驗「世 界童軍一家」的精神,並促進童軍 運動中團結的力量。同時Moot也向 全世界宣揚童軍活動的良好形象: 一個讓年輕人開放地學習成長、藉 以培養國家及國際社會中良好公民 的世界性運動。


